Services provided

The Multicultural Day Care Program offers transport to and from the client's home on one of our buses.



Delicious and nutritious multicultural meals are provided and cater to the client's needs, for example halal, vegetarian, etc.

All services are planned and developed to ensure the linguistic, cultural and religious needs of our clients are met.

Clients have access to a range of activities during the day, including:

- ❑ Games, tai chi, gentle exercise, playing cards, music, videos, story telling, information and guest speakers on a variety of issues; and
- ❑ Excursions/outings to various attractions, parks, beaches, museums, etc.



Eligibility

An assessment will be conducted to ensure the prospective client meets the criteria for the program and his/her needs are met.

Our groups

Bilingual and bi-cultural staff conduct all programs. Our current day care groups include **Cantonese and Mandarin, Egyptian, German, Greek, Arabic-speaking, Macedonian, Maltese, Muslim women (Arabic-speaking), Italian, Russian and Spanish.**

Group participants or visitors will be asked to contribute a set fee for this service. The fee and payment arrangements will be decided during the assessment.
